Objectives


- To recognize and reward outstanding academic performance and potential.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for a free ship, a student must meet the following criteria:

- Be a bonafide student of MIPER pursuing a pharmacy program (B. Pharm, Pharm. D)
- Have secured a minimum academic score as defined by the institute (e.g., 80% or above in the previous year's exams)
- Demonstrate financial need through documented proof of income and family circumstances.
- Preference may be given to students from underprivileged backgrounds, rural areas, or specific groups as determined by the institute.

Selection Process

- Applications for free ships will be invited annually through official institute communication channels.
- A selection committee, comprising faculty members and administrative representatives, will be formed to evaluate applications based on the defined criteria.
- The selection committee will consider the student's academic record, financial need, and any other relevant factors as deemed appropriate.
- The selection process will be transparent and fair, and all applicants will be informed of the outcome.

Types of Free Ships

- **Full Free Ship:** Covers the entire tuition fee for the academic year.
- **Partial Free Ship:** Covers a specific percentage of the tuition fee (e.g., 50%, 75%).
- **Merit-Based Free Ship:** Awarded solely based on academic performance.
- **Need-Based Free Ship:** Awarded based on financial need and academic merit.
- **Specific Group Free Ship:** Awarded to students from specific backgrounds as determined by the institute.

Renewal of Free Ships

- The renewal of free ships will be subject to the student maintaining good academic standing and meeting the established financial need criteria.
- Renewal applications will be reviewed annually.

Responsibilities of Free Ship Recipients

- Free ship recipients are expected to maintain good academic performance and ethical conduct.
- They may be required to contribute to community service activities as determined by the institute.
- They must report any changes in their financial circumstances to the institute authorities.
