Objective:

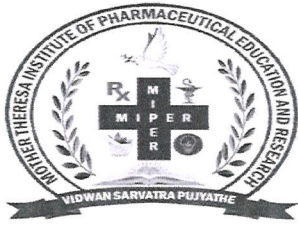
