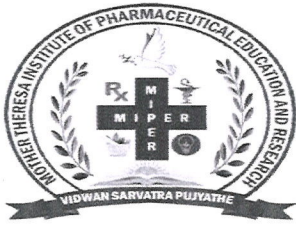

Q&A Session and Closing Remarks (3:30 PM - 4:30 PM):

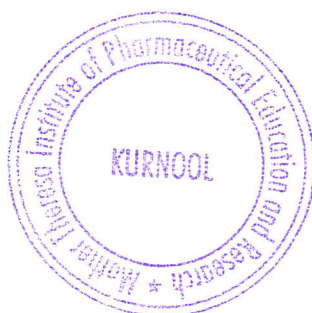

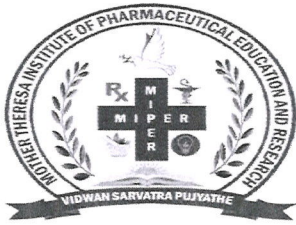
Participants:
